

## **Small Businesses Eligible for Disaster Assistance**

For those Small Businesses unable to attend the Emergency Meeting on Sunday about Disaster Assistance, the following information may be of help to you:

- ❖ A Central Service Centre has been established at the Kinsmen Arena. Today (July 5) and tomorrow, it will be open from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm. For additional hours, check the City website at [www.yorkton.ca](http://www.yorkton.ca)
- ❖ Applications for assistance from the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program are available at the Centre or you can call the Ministry of Corrections, Public Safety and Policing at 1-866-632-4033. You have until January 1, 2011 to submit your application.
- ❖ Information about the Disaster Assistance Program is available at the Centre and on the Ministry's website [www.cpsp.gov.sk.ca](http://www.cpsp.gov.sk.ca)
- ❖ Document all your activities related to cleanup process:
  - Keep track of all the time you spend cleaning up
  - Keep track of all the equipment that is used
  - Keep all invoices and store them in a safe place
  - Keep samples of the damage ie. Carpeting, gyro, etc
  - Take photos of everything that has been damaged
- ❖ For information on mold removal, check the Ministry of Health's website [www.health.gov.sk.ca](http://www.health.gov.sk.ca)
- ❖ If your business is incorporated, the claim is filed under the name of the corporation.
- ❖ A small business is eligible to file one claim per disaster for a maximum of \$160,000.
